Community Health Needs Assessment

- NHS engaged John Snow, Inc. (JSI) a public health research and consulting firm as the project consultant
- **Three Phase Project**
 - Phase I – Secondary Data Review
 - Phase II – Community Input
 - Phase III –Reporting & Prioritization
- **The project was designed to:**
 - Highlight community health and social service needs
 - Inform and motivate targeted communities served by Addison Gilbert Hospital
 - Encourage and foster community dialogue
 - Organize groundwork for community based partnerships
 - Leverage existing community resources
 - Guide Addison Gilbert Hospital community health investments

Random Sample Survey

Gloucester - 413 respondents / 808 surveys mailed / response rate 51%

Rockport - 124 respondents / 259 surveys mailed / response rate 48%



Community Forums

- Lahey Health & Addison Gilbert Hospital have hosted four bi-annual community forums to discuss recent updates and developments in health care at Lahey Health and Addison Gilbert Hospital. Each forum was moderated and included a question and answer session.

Cape Ann Panel

- The Cape Ann Community Panel provides oversight to the community process and brings objective community perspective, while representing diverse community experience, to the Addison Gilbert Hospital (AGH) planning process during the three-year evaluation period.

Form Cape Ann Emergency Services Panel

- This panel, comprised of police, fire and other public safety officials; has served in an advisory capacity, bringing informative, objective and diverse perspective and experience to ensure emergency services on Cape Ann adequately serve the needs of the community.

Addison Gilbert Hospital - Emergency Department

Preservation of Addison Gilbert Hospital Emergency Department

- Approximately 15,000 annual visits, cannot be absorbed at any other emergency departments
- Investments
 - ED-SBIRT Program and pediatric expansion
 - New equipment (CT Scanner, monitors and equipment)
- No plans to close or materially limit services in the Addison Gilbert Emergency Department


